The overall objective of the project is to improve legal and civil education of students and youth, based on propagation of democratic values and freedom directed on formation of an active civil position in Osh and Jalalabat oblasts of the south of Kyrgyz Republic. The target groups of the action are 2000 students, 450 youth (from 18-25 year old, at least 50% women), 20 youth organizations and 12 state structures from Osh and Jalalabat oblasts of the South of Kyrgyzstan.
